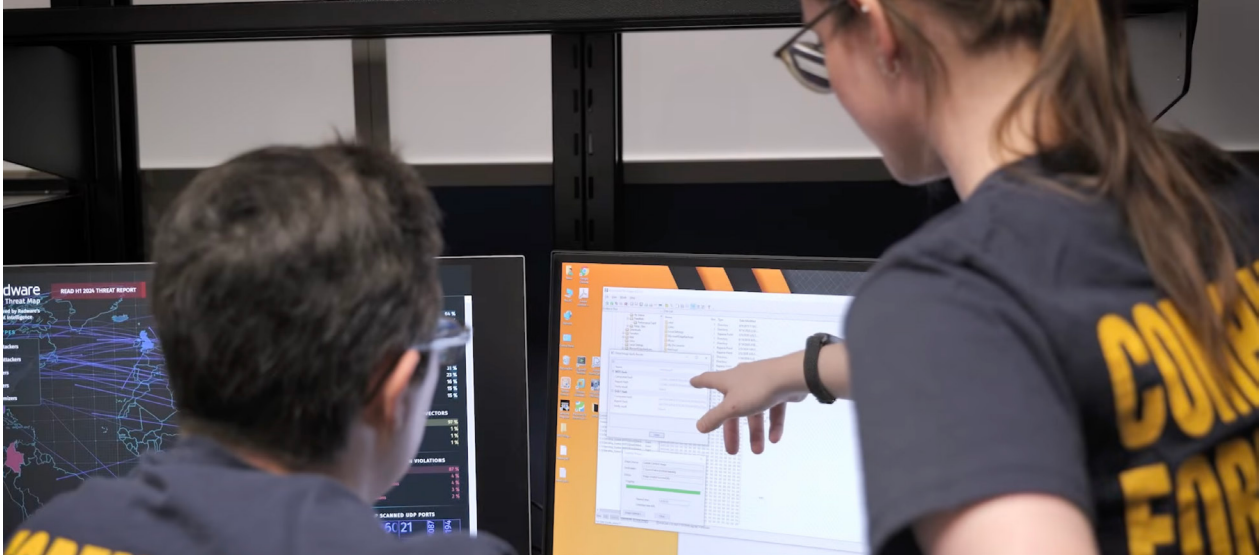




Our Impact

As the law enforcement arm of NASA's Office of Inspector General, the Office of Investigations pursues allegations of crime, cybercrime, fraud, waste, abuse, and misconduct that jeopardize Agency programs, projects, and personnel. We protect your hard-earned tax dollars by holding wrongdoers accountable, identifying crime

indicators, and making recommendations to address vulnerabilities. We refer our findings to Congress for review, the Department of Justice for prosecution, or NASA management for corrective action.

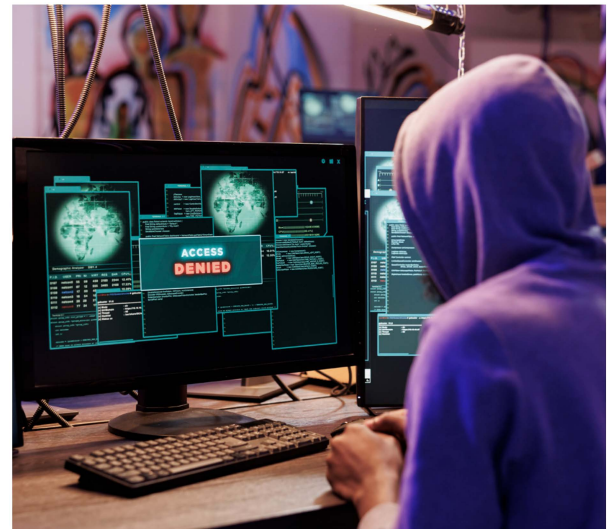

How We Serve

Our elite team is composed of highly trained special agents, technical investigators, digital forensic examiners, forensic accountants, program specialists, and support personnel stationed at NASA headquarters and centers throughout the country.

Together, we

- perform joint investigations with law enforcement partners to develop cases for criminal prosecution, civil litigation, or administrative action;
- make recommendations to NASA management that protect the Agency from increasingly complex and evolving threats;
- operate a hotline that allows NASA employees, contractors, and the public to report suspected fraud, waste, and abuse; and
- provide fraud awareness training to NASA employees, contractors, grant recipients, and other stakeholders.
