

Audit Report, “Information Technology Security Controls on NASA’s Administrative Systems and Networks in [NASA Installations]” (IG-05-027, September 30, 2005)

The NASA Office of Inspector General conducted a review to determine whether controls at selected NASA installations were adequate to ensure the information technology (IT) security of NASA data and resources and to mitigate risks to other NASA systems and networks connected to the selected ones.

We found that controls over NASA facilities and on administrative computer systems and networks at the NASA installations we evaluated were not sufficient to ensure the IT security of administrative data and resources. However, NASA was taking appropriate actions to address our recommendations.
